What does a virtual school day look like?

- Students are required to log on and participate in their classes during the scheduled class time (as noted on previous slide)
 - Students are expected to be present during each scheduled class period
- Attendance will be taken daily for all virtual learners
 - Students can join via video conferencing or by dialing in on a phone
- Virtual sessions will be a combination of synchronous and asynchronous instructional strategies with teachers providing live instruction daily
- Brain breaks from the screen have been built into the daily schedule

What Will Instruction Look Like?

- Teachers will record upload assignments and resources to their Google Classrooms
- If a student doesn't participate in the live lesson, they will be marked absent and responsible for viewing the recording of the day's lesson as well as completing any assignments from that class prior to their return to their virtual class
- Teachers will be utilizing Google Classroom to post and collect all assignments
